

SAMPLE Child Care Provider Transportation Agreement

In operating a childcare program, our first responsibility is to protect the health and safety of the children in our care. When parents drop off and pick up their children, we want to make sure the children are transported safely. When a parent transports children under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or fails to use an appropriate car seat, it creates an unsafe transportation situation for the children. If, in our opinion, a child cannot be transported safely to or from our site, we will ask the parent not to transport the child and will propose the alternatives listed below. (If the parent refuses to agree to one of the alternatives and insists on transporting the child, we will call the police immediately and report the unsafe transportation situation.)

1) We will call a person from the following list of people who are authorized to transport the child.

2) We will call a cab or other commercial service to pick up the child, car seat, and the parent. The parent will pay the fare.

3) If the parent has failed to bring a car seat for the child, we will ask the parent to drive home without the child and return with a car seat installed in the car.
